

The Regional Telecommunications Technical Commission (COMTELCA), is the specialized agency in Telecommunications of the Central American Integration System (SICA), based on the Central American Telecommunications Treaty and its Protocol, has among its Designated Members with Mexico, Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Panama and the Dominican Republic.

In response to the invitation from the organizers of the 7th Latin American Telecommunications Congress (CLT), COMTELCA will hold its 152nd Ordinary Meeting of the Board of Directors, within the framework of the CLT.

Among the topics that will be discussed during the 152nd Ordinary Meeting will be the transfer of the pro-tempore presidency, this activity by the legal framework, officially takes place on July 23 of each year, in this opportunity, the presidency will be transferred by the Designated Member from Nicaragua, Instituto Nicaragüense de Telecomunicaciones y Correos (TELCOR) to the Designated Member from Mexico, Secretaría de Comunicaciones y Transporte (SCT), in the same act, the representative from la Superintendencia General de Electricidad y Telecomunicaciones de El Salvador (SIGET) will assume the vice-presidency, In addition, the Board of Directors will receive a preliminary report on the topics to be discussed at the next World Radiocommunication Conference (WRC) to be held in October and November and the actions carried out for its development, as well as the work carried out by the other COMTELCA committees (Standardization, Development and Legal) and the development of their working plans.
